We award our laureates HK\$15m (around US\$1.9m) in project funding over three years. This is your chance to tell us in two minutes—and in your own words—what you'd spend it on. Most people record their video in English, but you don't have to; just remember to include English subtitles.

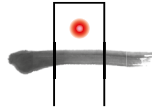

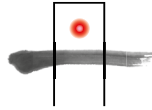
